Required Books

1. Schwarz & Lathrope, *Fundamentals of Corporate Taxation* (9th ed. 2016). Older editions are way too out-of-date to be used safely. This new edition should be easy to re-sell if you take good care of it.

2. Lathrope (ed.), *Selected Federal Taxation Statutes and Regulations* (West, “2017” edition, published in summer 2016; or “2016” edition, published in summer 2015). Please have the “2017” or “2016” edition of the Code (2017 preferred). Older editions may not have all the materials we will be using, particularly in the regulations. There should be plenty of used copies of the 2017 edition around, as they were used in big sections of Income Tax I in the fall term just concluded.

Please bring your Code volume and the casebook with you to every class.

Assignment for First Week

Study pages 1–43 of the Casebook. Be prepared to discuss the problem on page 31.

Skim pages 43 (bottom) – 52.

Study the Internal Revenue Code and Regulations sections cited in the casebook chapter. Like all tax courses, Corporate Tax is a statutory affair – always look to the Code and regulations!
